Clinical skills

I am competent in the assessment of Mental Capacity in patients presenting with neuropsychiatric disorders. I am also competent in the assessment and management of complex neuropsychiatric conditions including traumatic brain injury, chronic fatigue syndrome; sleep disorders, epilepsy, non-epileptic attack disorders, somatoform disorders, and general neuropsychiatric disorders. I also have expertise in the assessment and management of general psychiatric disorders arising from trauma e.g. Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD). I am competent in the assessment and management of adults with a neurodevelopmental disorder including ADHD and ASD. I am competent in the use of relevant psychopharmacological treatments and other physical treatments in the management of patients with neuropsychiatric conditions. I am able to diagnose and treat patients with medically

unexplained symptoms. I am able to interpret neuropsychological test results sufficiently to produce a neuropsychiatric formulation. I am able to undertake the clinical assessment of patients presenting with neuropsychiatric disorders and request relevant investigations.

I have excellent interpersonal and consulting skills as well as strong problem solving abilities and clinical expertise. I am a team player with a strong record of patient engagement and advocacy. I regularly attend medico-legal courses/training annually as part of my Continuous Professional Development (CPD) and I have successfully completed the Bond Solon Expert Witness Certificate from Cardiff University in 2014.
